1. Minutes of the May 17, 1994 meeting were read, motion was made by Angela Diehm to accept and seconded by Stacy Parramore.
2. Paul Bartholomew made a motion to nominate Kelley Felix for Vice-chairman. Stacy Paramore seconded and the motion passed.
3. Paul Bartholomew asked Lloyd Henderson about trash cans. If there are enough or has the city manager received complaints.

Angela Diehm asked about Volley Ball pit. The Chamber of Commerce needs to find out more information.

Paul Bartholomew asked Lloyd Henderson about Miles Road grant that fell through. Will try again in July 1994 and a decision should be expected in January 1995.

4. Reviewed the Preliminary Park Master Plan regarding two (2) ball fields, a playground and jogging trails were proposed. The City Council will look at final grant at their July 5, 1994 meeting.
5. Budget for 1994-1995 year was discussed and Lloyd Henderson advised that the staff will give a Parks and Recreation Board budget to look at and discuss at a future meeting.

Current budget ends on September 31, 1994 and the new budget year begins on October 1, 1994.

Lloyd Henderson advised flex base for parking lots from Highway 78 project.

Charles Schaefer advised that water spouts are needed for ball fields.

The need for pea gravel for extensions and on playgrounds was suggested.

Lloyd Henderson advised that we need to give him a "wish list" of items needed by the Parks and Recreation Board. This list needs to be done by July 26, 1994.

Terri Hibbs proposed park upgrade. Angela Diehm suggested getting donations to upgrade the park. Terri Hibbs is going to work on a plan for Salmon Park improvements.

6. Paul Bartholomew suggested the need for a Park and Recreation Director. The idea received little support and was tabled.

Terri Hibbs advised that a neighbor had suggested donating land at Salmon and Sachse Roads for a neighborhood park.

7. Terri Hibbs made a motion to adjourn and Charles Schaefer seconded. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
