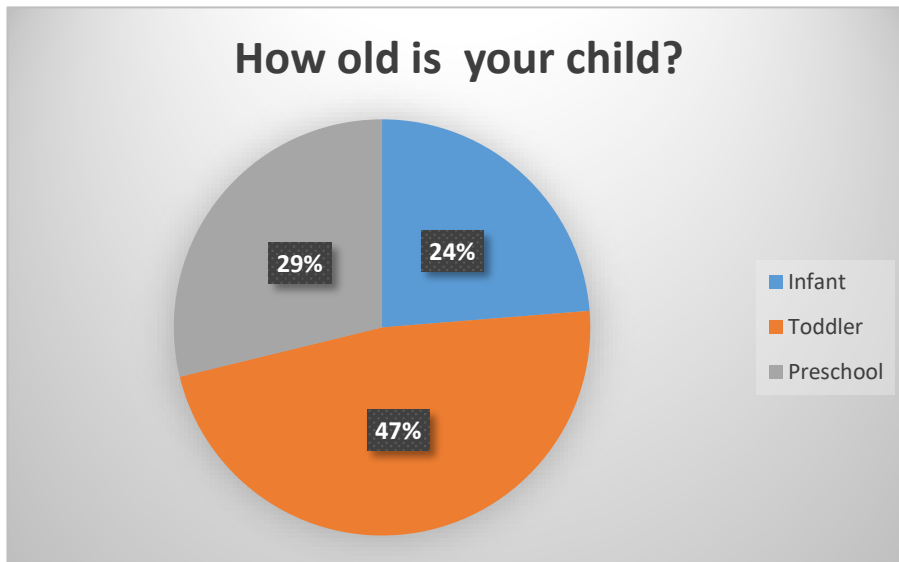

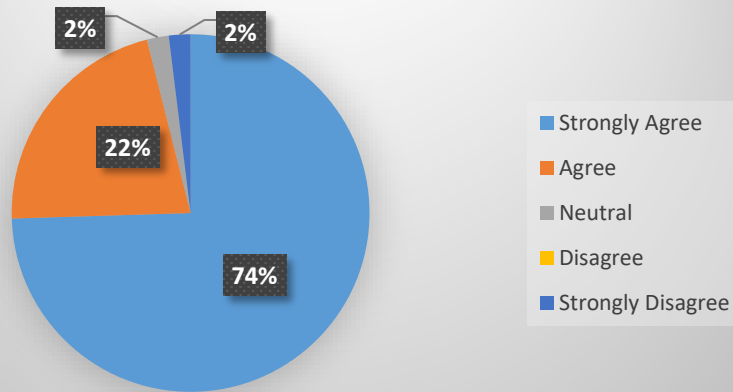

Story Time Parent Survey



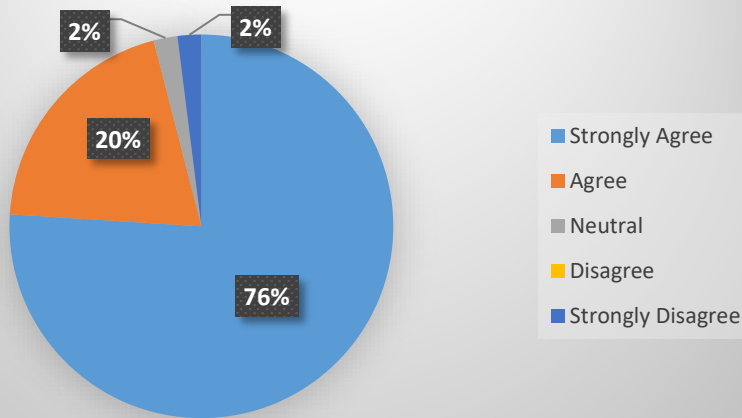

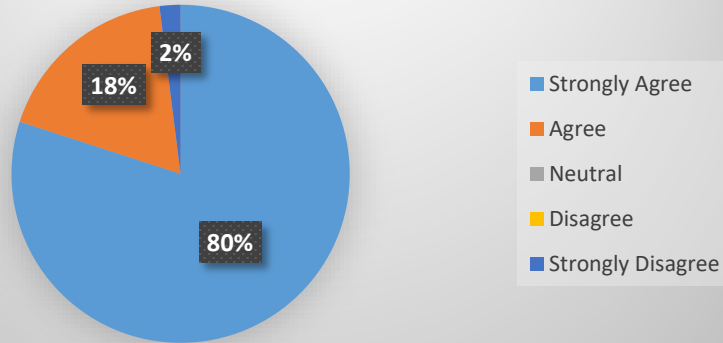

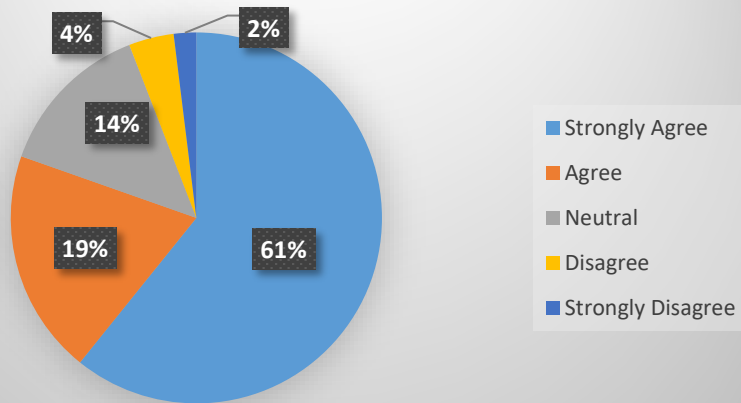
