The invocation was offered by Councilman King and the pledges were led by Councilman Franks.

Councilman Bickerstaff moved to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of: 13-1963 Consider approval of the minutes of the December 19, 2013, special meeting; 13-1940 Resolution No. 3554 of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas, authorizing the application for the 2014 Texas Book Festival Grants including the Collection Enhancement Grant and the Literacy Initiative Grant; and 13-1965 Consider receiving the Monthly Revenue and Expenditure Report for the period ending November 30, 2013. Background

The majority of police departments in Texas are small organizations, with many being staffed by under ten and even five officers. These departments are generally not funded at a level needed to equip a more modern police agency. The Texas Police Chief's Association has created a bulletin board on its website that allows for the posting of surplus police equipment and property that can be obtained, without cost, by smaller departments. Sachse Police would like to take advantage of this opportunity to, in a small way, help improve policing in Texas.

Policy Considerations

Allow disposal of excess equipment and property.

Budgetary Considerations

It is possible that the City could sell some of the items for salvage, for a very small amount.

Executive Summary

This zoning amendment will establish regulations for Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Store and Hookah/Smoke Lounge uses, as well as provide clarification in definitions for regulations pertaining to Retail Tobacco Store establishments.

Background

Recently, the City of Sachse has received numerous requests pertaining to Retail Electronic Cigarette stores. Within the last several months, two of these establishments have received Certificates of Occupancy and are currently open for business. Because of this demand, the City of Sachse is taking a proactive approach to regulate these uses.

The sale of Electronic Cigarettes currently occurs as an ancillary sale in existing retail establishments or as the primary sale within Retail Electronic Cigarette stores. In addition, Retail Electronic Cigarette stores have also expanded operations to allow for lounge areas for patrons; this expansion alters the business operation from typical retail sales.

In the past, the City of Sachse has adopted the following regulations pertaining to the sale/use/possession of tobacco, cigarette, smoking paraphernalia, and e-cigarettes:

- The City of Sachse adopted zoning regulations for Retail Tobacco Stores and Smoking Paraphernalia Establishments on May 3, 2010 via Ordinance Number 3209.
- On December 2, 2013 via Ordinance Number 3551, the City of Sachse adopted E-Cigarette Regulations with the main purpose being to prohibit the purchase, use, or possession of e-cigarettes by minors; and to prohibit the sale of e-cigarettes to minors.

On January 13, 2013, Planning and Zoning Commission voted 7-0 to recommend approval of this Ordinance request, with the emendation to include electronic cigarette devices in the definition for items to comprise the sales within a Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Store.

Policy Considerations

Establishing regulations for the sale and use of tobacco/e-cigarette products is consistent with the City Council's goals of protecting health, safety and general welfare of the community. This is evidenced by the aforementioned Code of Ordinance amendments (Ord. No. 3209 and Ord. No. 3551). Ordinance Number 3209 was aimed at regulating the sales of tobacco and smoking paraphernalia. The intent of Ordinance Number 3551 was to prohibit the purchase, use, or possession of e-cigarettes by minors; and to prohibit the sale of e-cigarettes to minors.

The purpose of this Zoning Ordinance amendment is to further previous objectives by providing regulations for Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Stores and Hookah/Smoke Lounge uses. In summary, the proposed amendment would accomplish the following:

Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Store

The language in the proposed amendment will provide a definition for a new use -

Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Store, and provide regulations in the Permitted Uses table that would permit the use as a Special Use Permit in the General Commercial C-2 District, Restricted Manufacturing and Warehousing I-1 District and General Industrial I-2 District.

The below definition will allow for ease in classification of the use by explaining the operation and quantifying the portion of the establishment dedicated to this use:

“A business establishment for which more than 50% of the gross floor area is dedicated to the storage, mixing, display and/or retail sale of nicotine-enriched solutions and/or liquid products that are manufactured for use with e-cigarettes.”

Hookah/Smoke Lounge

The language in the proposed amendment will provide a definition for a new use - Hookah/Smoke Lounge, and provide regulations in the Permitted Uses table that would permit the use as a Special Use Permit in the Restricted Manufacturing and Warehousing I-1 District and General Industrial I-2 District.

As stated in the Background section of this staff report, some Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Stores have provided lounge areas to allow for on-site use/consumption of products purchased. The inclusion of a lounge area alters the function of the retail establishment; therefore, this additional use is proposed.

Retail Tobacco Store

The language in the proposed amendment will provide clarification for the Retail Tobacco store definition to allow for a more objective and quantifiable determination of use based on floor area. The current language defines a Retail Tobacco store as a “... store that sells mainly tobacco products...”; the amended definition defines a Retail Tobacco store as a “...business establishment for which more than 50% of the gross floor area is dedicated to the display and retail sale of tobacco products...”. The full language of the Retail Tobacco Store definition is included in the attached Draft Ordinance. The above references only include the language pertaining to quantifying the use.

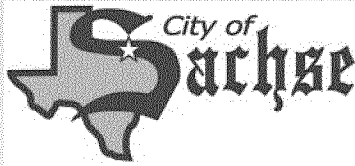
It should be noted that if this Ordinance is passed, existing uses would be classified as Legal Nonconforming Uses and would be permitted to continue provided they are not abandoned for a period greater than six months. For clarification, the abandonment pertains to the use and not the operator/proprietor of the establishment.

BACKGROUND

HISTORY/TIMELINE

In the past, the City of Sachse has adopted the following regulations pertaining to the sale/use/possession of tobacco, cigarette, smoking paraphernalia, and e-cigarettes:

- ☐ The City of Sachse adopted zoning regulations for Retail Tobacco Stores and Smoking Paraphernalia Establishments on May 3, 2010 via Ord. No. 3209.
- ☐ On December 2, 2013 via Ord. No. 3551, the City of Sachse adopted E-Cigarette Regulations with the main purpose being to prohibit the purchase, use, or possession of e-cigarettes by minors; and to prohibit the sale of e-cigarettes to minors.

For clarification purpose, a hookah/smoke lounge and/or any other similar uses shall be considered an individual business class separated from a Retail Tobacco Store or a Retail Electronic-Cigarette/ Vaporizer Store.”

Retail Tobacco Store

- ☐ Clarification of Definition

Definition

“A business establishment for which more than 50% of the gross floor area is dedicated to the display and retail sale of tobacco products such a cigars, pipe tobacco and cigarettes. This business may also sell tobacco accessories such as lighters, matches, cigarette holders and devices used to preserve tobacco, cigars or cigarettes, which are merely incidental to the sale of tobacco products.”



STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the Ordinance as presented.

Planning & Zoning Commission Recommendation

On January 13, 2013, Planning and Zoning Commission voted 7-0 to recommend approval of this Ordinance request, with the amendment to include electronic cigarette devices in the definition for items to comprise the sales within a Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Store.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 11 "ZONING," ARTICLE 2, BY ADDING DEFINITIONS FOR ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE OR E-CIGARETTE, HOOKAH/SMOKE LOUNGE, RETAIL ELECTRONIC-CIGARETTE/VAPORIZER STORE; BY AMENDING THE DEFINITION FOR RETAIL TOBACCO STORE; BY AMENDING SCHEDULE I "PERMITTED USES" TO ADD HOOKAH/SMOKE LOUNGE USE IN RESTRICTED MANUFACTURING AND WAREHOUSING I-1 DISTRICT AND GENERAL INDUSTRIAL I-2 DISTRICT BY APPROVAL OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT; BY AMENDING SCHEDULE I "PERMITTED USES" TO ADD RETAIL ELECTRONIC-CIGARETTE/VAPORIZER STORE IN GENERAL COMMERCIAL C-2 DISTRICT, RESTRICTED MANUFACTURING AND WAREHOUSING I-1 DISTRICT AND GENERAL INDUSTRIAL I-2 DISTRICT BY APPROVAL OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sachse adopted the Zoning Regulations for the protection of the public health and general welfare of the people of the City of Sachse; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and the Planning and Zoning Commission have recognized that certain provisions of the Zoning Regulations should be reviewed and updated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has a substantial interest in promoting the public health, safety, and welfare of the community and also promoting land use compatibility within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to develop reasonable regulations regarding the location of retail tobacco stores, retail electronic cigarette/vaporizer stores and hookah/ smoke lounges; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Sachse and the governing body of the City of Sachse, in compliance with state laws applying to amending the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and Map, have given the requisite notice by publication and otherwise, and after holding due hearings and affording a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally, the governing body of the City of Sachse is of the opinion that said comprehensive zoning ordinance should be amended as provided herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances, City of Sachse, Texas, be amended, by amending Chapter 11, Zoning, in part, to read as follows:

Electronic Cigarette or E-Cigarette. Any device that uses an atomizer or similar device that allows users to inhale nicotine vapor or other vapor without the use of fire, smoke, or ash. The definition of e-cigarette shall include, but is not limited to, electronic cigars, electronic cigarillos, or electronic pipe, and any cartridge or other component of the device or related product including any liquid products that are manufactured for use with e-cigarettes.

Hookah/Smoke Lounge. A business establishment for which the configuration of the floor area is to facilitate on-site consumption of tobacco, cigarette, and nicotine-enriched solutions. For clarification purpose, a hookah/smoke lounge and/or any other similar uses shall be considered an individual business class separated from a Retail Tobacco Store or a Retail Electronic-Cigarette/ Vaporizer Store.

Retail Electronic-Cigarette/Vaporizer Store. A business establishment for which more than 50% of the gross floor area is dedicated to the storage, mixing, display and/or retail sale of electronic cigarette devices, nicotine-enriched solutions and/or liquid products that are manufactured for use with e-cigarettes.

....

Retail Tobacco Store. A business establishment for which more than 50% of the gross floor area is dedicated to the display and retail sale of tobacco products such a cigars, pipe tobacco and cigarettes. This business may also sell tobacco accessories such as lighters, matches, cigarette holders and devices used to preserve tobacco, cigars or cigarettes, which are merely incidental to the sale of tobacco products.

SECTION 2. All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Sachse, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Should any word, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance, as amended hereby, be adjudged or held to be invalid, void or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. An offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by the prior law and provisions of the Code of Ordinances, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this Ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Code of Ordinances, as hereby amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000) for each offense, and each and every day such violation shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
