The City Council of the City of Sachse held a Regular Meeting on Monday, November 19, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. at the Sachse City Hall after proper notice. The roll of the duly constituted City Council Members was called which members as follows, to wit:

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to U.S. and Texas Flags:

The invocation was offered by Councilman Timm and the pledges were led by Councilman Adams.

1. Consent Agenda:

Councilman Timm moved to approve Consent Agenda No. 12-1206 Consider approval of the minutes of the November 5, 2012, regular meeting (as corrected); 12-1222 Consider the acceptance of the resignation of Jordan Dean from the Board of Adjustments; 12-1226 Consider the acceptance of the resignation of Bill Alexander from the Library Board; 12-1229 Resolution No. 3434 of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas, awarding the bid for the Boone Street Paving Improvements from Sachse Road to 5th Street as a Community Development Block Grant project to Reynolds Asphalt & Construction Company, Incorporated in the amount totaling \$55,354.00; authorizing the City Manager to execute such agreement in a form approved by the City Attorney; and providing an effective date; and 12-1221 Ordinance No. 3435 of the City of Sachse, Texas, abandoning all right, title and interest in portions of Hooper Road and Cody Lane described and depicted in Exhibit "A", attached hereto; to the abutting property owner, Woodbridge Properties, LLC; providing for the furnishing of a certified copy of this ordinance for recording in the official public records of Collin County, Texas, as a Quitclaim deed; authorizing the City Manager to execute any documents necessary to complete abandonment; and providing for an effective date. The motion was seconded by Councilman Adams and carried unanimously.

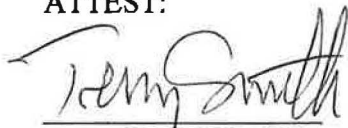

12-1205 Consider a date for the Independence Day event, the Red, White & Blue Blast:

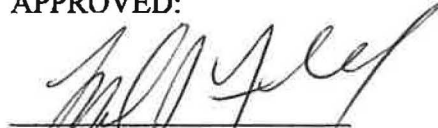
