BACKGROUND

At its May 12 special meeting, the City Council ordered a Runoff Election for the purpose of electing a Councilmember Place 4. The City's contracts with Dallas County and Collin County for the May General Election remained in force.

In order to declare the results official, the City Council must canvass the results. The proposed ordinance will declare the results for Councilmember Place 4 with the term expiring in May 2029.

**The ordinance may be updated to include any qualified mail and provisional ballots when the counties have completed their count.*

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

The City Charter specifies that the returns of every election shall be made in accordance with the Texas Election Code, and that the City Council shall canvass the votes and declare the results of such election.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the ordinance canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the Runoff Election held on Saturday, June 13, 2026.

ORDINANCE NO. O-2026-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON SATURDAY, JUNE 13, 2026, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 4; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that the notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by law, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas and the proceedings calling and governing the holding of such election; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to consider the returns of the election held on June 13, 2026, for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named official; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been duly and legally made and submitted to the City Council for canvassing, and a tabulation of the returns for the polling place and for early voting, as canvassed and tabulated by this governing body for the election of Councilmember Place 4, are as follows:

It appearing that Tim Legh-Page received a majority of all votes cast for the Office of Councilmember Place 4, he is hereby declared to be elected to the Office of City Councilmember Place Four to serve a term that shall expire May 2029, after qualifying.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Said election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with the law, and that said election was held in accordance with the law, and that Tim Legh-Page was duly elected as Councilmember Place Four. Time Legh-Page is hereby declared duly elected to the City Council as Councilmember Place Four, subject to taking his oath as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 2. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place, and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient and readily accessible to the

general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least three business days preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
