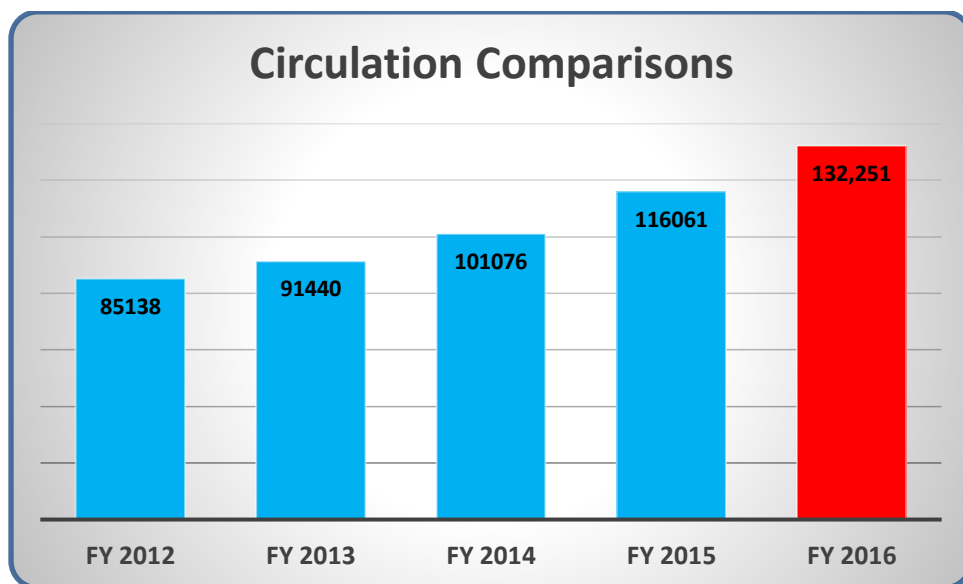

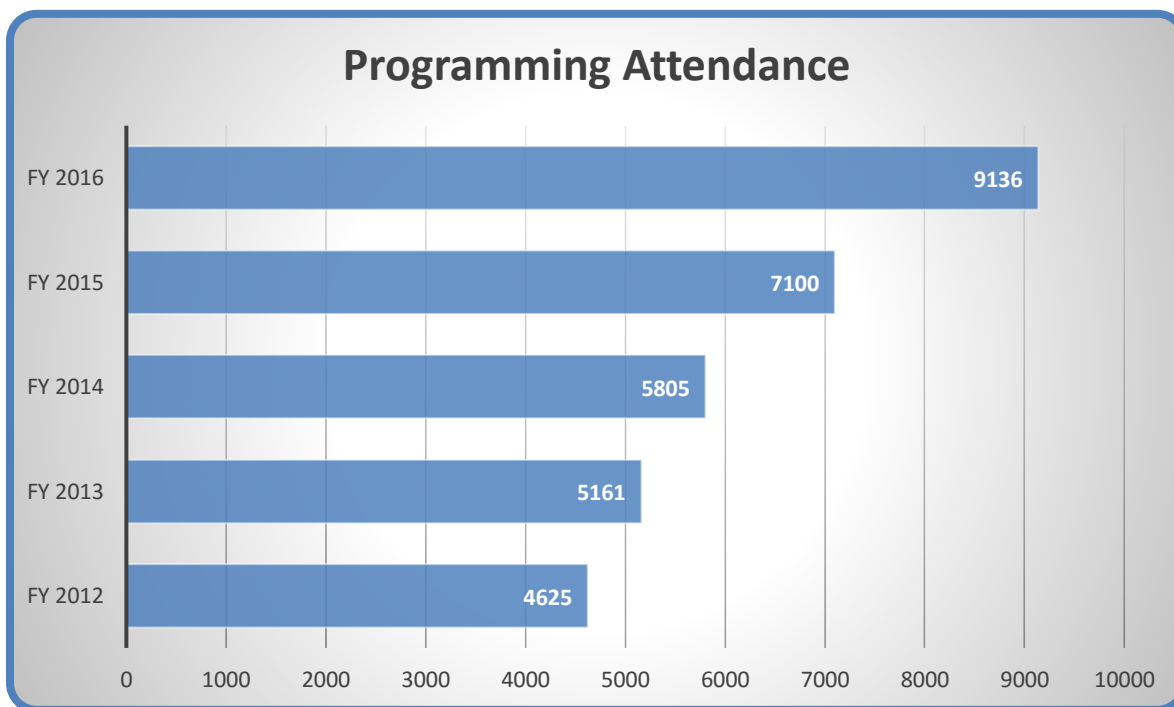

THE YEAR IN REVIEW

The Sachse Public Library is a valuable community resource and continues to provide high quality service for the community. The City Council approved funds to bring the library up to date in the area of technology in FY 2015 with an RFID system which consists of two self-check systems and security gates that will provide accurate counts. Every library item available for checkout had to be tagged for the new system, and all new incoming items have to be tagged as well. A team was hired in October 2015 to tag materials. The process was complete in late October. Self-checks became available for the public by late October, and patrons responded positively to the additional options for checkouts.

The Library received a grant from the Hancher Foundation to replace the laptops and self-reserve station for the computer lab and to build an e-Audio book collection in FY 2015. Funds were spent in FY 2016. Library users are enjoying the new computers on a daily basis. The e-audio book collection now has approximately 500 items in it, and it is becoming a popular collection. Bibliotheca and 3M merged their companies in 2016 and they are providing great service.

The Library closed in December 2015 for its first all day Staff Development Day. Staff from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission did a special training for the library staff on basic reference services and presented databases that are available through Texshare. Staff thoroughly enjoyed the day and put the knowledge to good use by sharing databases with library users.

There has been an increase in circulation every month in FY 2016. In June 2016, we broke our circulation record with 14,894 checkouts, the highest number of checkouts ever in a single month. Another record breaker was the number of checkouts the Library had in FY 2016 (132,251), an increase of 13%. The area of heaviest usage continues to be children's books with almost 72,000 checkouts.

We also provide our patrons with access to books from libraries all over the country through interlibrary loans. This service allows us to offer our patrons options beyond

our own collection. This FY we increased our interlibrary loan usage by 33%. The usage has soared in the last five years with a 56% increase in checkouts.

The monthly calendar is available on the City's website and in the Library. It provides citizens with information on library programs and announcements. In addition, the Library Manager publishes a column in the *Sachse News*, and library events are frequently featured on the front page. The library staff maintains a Facebook page which can be found under Sachse Public Library. Other information resources include the City's biannual Parks and Recreation bulletin and program announcements on the Chamber of Commerce website.





Story Time



Story time for preschoolers is offered throughout the school year. There are two simultaneous story times. One is for toddlers and the other is for preschoolers. The weekly average attendance is 65 to 70 people.



Fall Programs

The Library's traditional Halloween costume contest and trick or treat entertained 235 children. With a packed house, the Library staff awarded prizes to costume contest winners. Children played a variety of games while trick or treating their way through the library.



The Library hosted a Thanksgiving feast just before the holiday with 64 in attendance. It was followed by the traditional Santa visit on December 3 with over 300 in attendance. Each child had an opportunity to visit with Santa, express their wishes and receive a free coloring book. Library staff also collected items for the animal shelter during December.



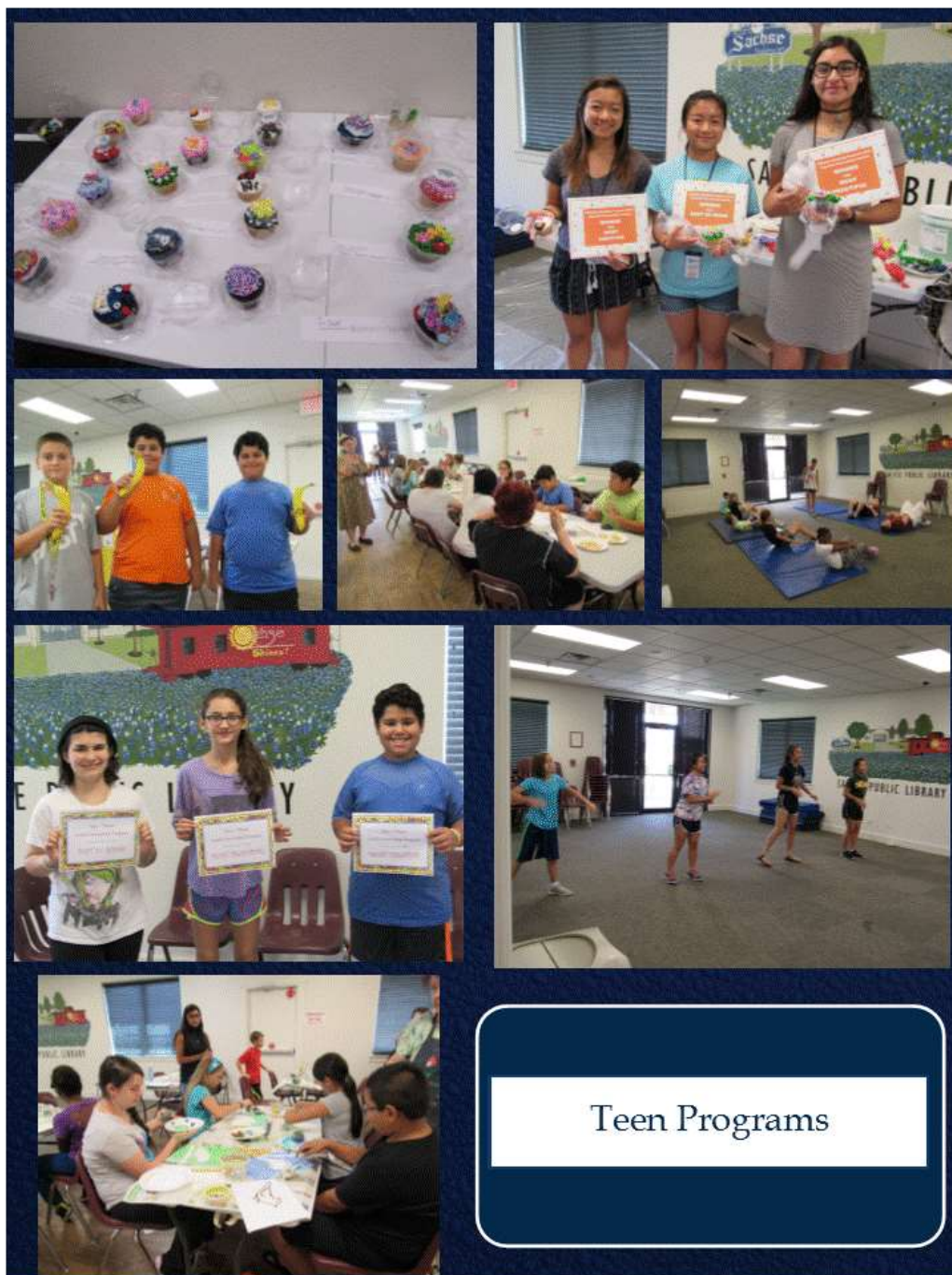


The Sachse Public Library hosted its second Sachse Author Con on May 21st from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 pm. This celebration of 25 local DFW authors featured titles ranging from children's picture books to young adult, as well as a variety of adult genres, including inspirational nonfiction, thriller and suspense novels. There were over 140 people in attendance.



Children's Programs

The New Year kicked off with Star Wars and Frozen themed events. Those popular events were followed by a Willy Wonka event in February. March brought a celebration of Dr. Seuss's birthday and his ever-popular books for children.



Teen Programs

Library staff have been working together the last few years to enhance teen/tween programs and draw more of this age group into the library. This summer's programs really attracted this age group with a cooking workshop, crafts, banana tattooing, painting with Janet Rogers and cupcake decorating which was the most popular program.



Summer Reading
Program

Summer Reading Club 2016 was a success with 800 people attending the kickoff and over 1100 registrations for children, teens, and adults. A big hit for the children's programs was David Chicken and the Bike Rodeo. The tweens and teens thoroughly enjoyed cookie decorating and cupcake decorating. The grand finale week included free burgers from IN-N-Out Burger, cupcake decorating, and a petting zoo with over 500 people in attendance. Overall there were over 3,600 attendees for the Summer Reading Club 2016 events.



August Programs

The Library continued children's programs into August with our Harry Potter program and Harmonic Motions, a children's ballet group, offered citizen's two performances of the play *Fancy Nancy & The Mermaid Ballet*. The library offered Colorpalooza, a coloring festival, and a local hero story time.
